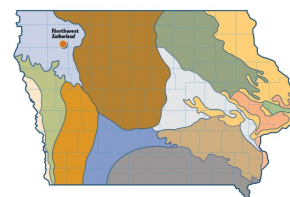
1 SW, 2 CM and 1 NM CCA credit will be available for this field day
